

To Register to Vote in Connecticut you must:

- be a United States Citizen;
- be a resident of a Connecticut town*;
- be at least 17 years old (must turn 18 before primary/election day;
- have completed confinement and parole if previously convicted of a felony

*Resident of a Connecticut town refers to where you lay your head (i.e. where you sleep at night.)

Warning: If you sign the statement even though you know it is untrue, you can be convicted and imprisoned for up to five years and fined up to \$5,000.
